* Homo sapiens sapiens

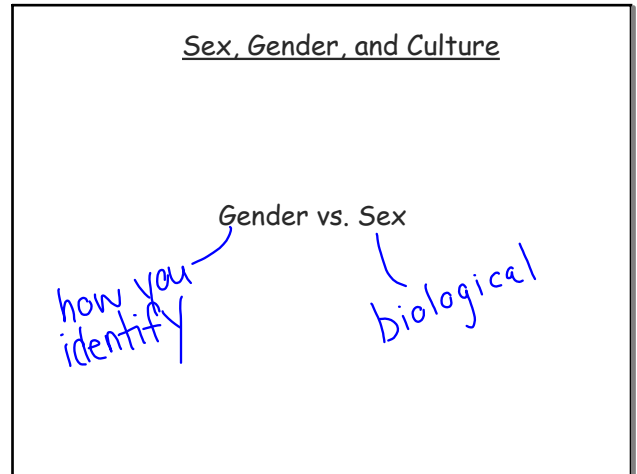
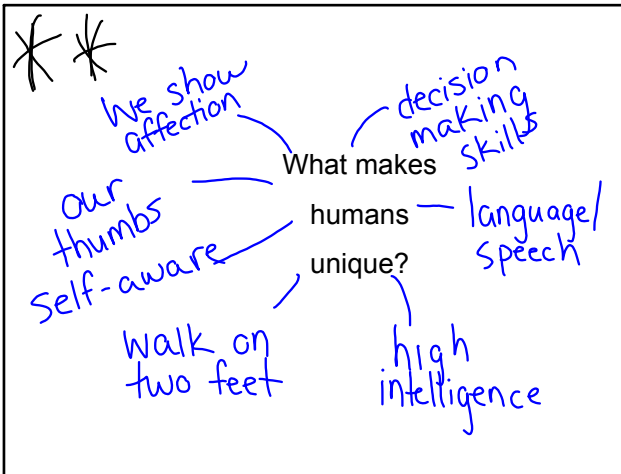
