

The Holocaust

Victims

- Any persons who were displaced, persecuted, or discriminated against due to racial, religious, social, and political policies of the Nazis and their collaborators between 1933 and 1945
- Although the Jewish community were the primary victims this also includes Gypsies, Polish, homosexuals, disabled (mentally and physically), etc.

Perpetrator

- Those that committed crimes or evil acts against the Jews and other undesirables

Bystander

- Ordinary people who played it safe, complied with the laws and tried to avoid the nazi regime
- They wanted to go on with their daily lives
- During the war, the collective world's response towards the Holocaust was minimal
- They may have been unaware
- They may have also been aware but did not help due to being fearful of the consequences

Helpers

- Those that assisted the undesirables in any way
- Acted in accordance with their belief systems or morals
- Thousands survived the Holocaust as a result of these individuals or groups
