Territory**

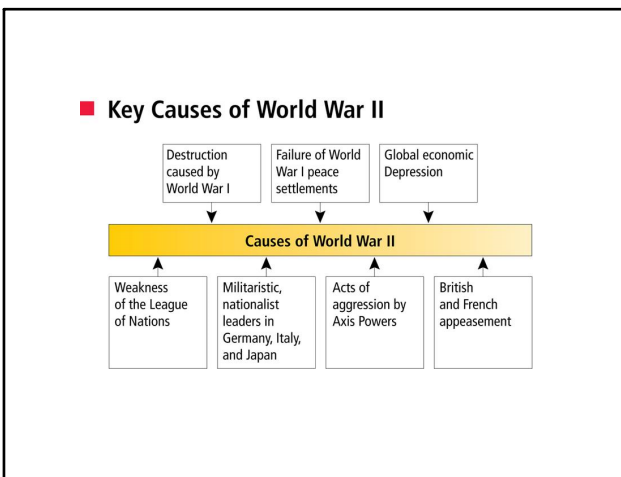
*Why would Germany have been upset after WWI?*

### What is fascism?

- Authoritarian political ideology
- Belief that the needs of the state are more important than the needs of the individual
- Seeks national unity from coercion and force
- Often seek to 'purify' their nation of foreign influences and ideas
- Feel that the 'most qualified' should rule, rather than everyone having a say (democracy)

### The Rise of Fascism

- Depression of the 1930's was world wide
- Many European countries struggled significantly through the depression
- Many European countries had major social and political problems following WWI and some turned towards extreme political views to solve their problems (i.e. communism and fascism)
